



Museum of American Finance presents: Museum Finance Academy

In the Museum Finance Academy, students will learn the basics of personal finance, including how to aspire to financial independence, develop an appreciation for savings, make financial goals and learn to avoid scams. Upon successful completion of the course, all students will receive a certificate.

The top four students of each session will be awarded a partial scholarship ranging from \$500 to \$1,000. Attendance is mandatory and cameras must be on at all times to qualify. Students will select one of two offered sessions and attend all five 75-minute classes. Students will be admitted on a first come, first served basis.

The enrichment program requires NO prior knowledge of finance or economics.
